### Instructions for Vasectomy

Please sign the consent for sterilization form after you have read the Facts about Vasectomy packet. This form must be brought with you on the day of the procedure. Failure to bring the consent with you on the day of the procedure may result in cancellation of the vasectomy.

If you have insurance, your benefits will be verified. If you have any out of pocket cost (including patients who do not have insurance) it will need to be paid in full, no later than 48 hours prior to the date of your procedure, or your procedure will be canceled.

At 6 weeks, when you are able to submit a specimen, please bring it in early, preferably before noon and it must be brought in on the day your doctor is in clinic so that your specimen can be checked by the doctor who performed your vasectomy. If you have questions about when your Doctor is in clinic, please contact our office.

All blood thinners should be stopped 3 days prior to the vasectomy. These thinning agents include but are not limited to; Plavix, Coumadin (Warfarin), Aspirin, NSAIDS, Heparin, Vitamin E, Garlic, Glucosamine, Pradaxa, and Omega 3 (greater than 2000mgs).
